Minutes of the Environment Committee Held on Monday 2nd February 2026
in the Bridlington Town Council Offices, 2A Marshall Avenue, Bridlington 12:00pm

A meeting was held with Four (4) Councillors M Heslop-Mullens, C Verda, Andy Walker, and Angie Walker
The Responsible Financial Officer recorded the minutes of the meeting.

131.25/26 The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting (with Notification of Recording & Fire Disclaimer).

132.25/26 Apologies for Absence:

RESOLVED: *Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr C Marsburg – due to ill health.*

133.25/26 Declarations of Interest:

a) To record declarations of interest by any member of the council in the report of the agenda items listed below. Members declaring interests should identify the agenda item and type of interest being declared.

RESOLVED: *All members present declared a non-pecuniary interest in item 9 as the Community Hub is the property of Bridlington Town Council.*

b) To note dispensations given by any member of the council in respect of the agenda items listed below.

RESOLVED: *There were none.*

134.25/26 Public Participation session to include items on the agenda (two minutes per person – maximum of 15 minutes) to include members of the Public and Councillors with non-pecuniary interests.

RESOLVED: *There were no members of public present.*

135.25/26 To receive the update on the Promenade of Fame (Cllr Andy Walker):

RESOLVED: *The committee received an update from Cllr Andy Walker on the project. The next meeting is planned for 23rd of February and a visit to the proposed manufacturer is planned for 4th February. The committee received the proposed nomination form.*

RESOLVED: *The committee noted the details of the report and resolved to purchase three (3) fruit trees for plot 41 to the maximum of £200.00. The committee resolved to explore the feasibility of securing external funding for an accessible plots project, but any project would be subject to the requirements of the relevant upcoming legislation and therefore wouldn't be commenced until the details are known.*

RESOLVED: *The committee discussed the current provision and resolved to seek a meeting with David Reaney from ERYC Street Lighting to discuss the provision for now and for future.*

RESOLVED: *The committee resolved that it would like to hold an evening event commencing with the Lights switch on and then evening 'entertainments', details of which to be decided.*

RESOLVED: *The committee resolved to write to all current Hub Users to advise of the council's plans for 2026/2027.*

140.25/26 To consider the quotation for installation of cameras inside the Community Hub:

RESOLVED: *The committee resolved to accept the quotation for further CCTV cameras in the Hub.*

RESOLVED: *The committee received a verbal report from the RFO and resolved that unfortunately this would not be something the council could offer at this time.*
